UPDATE ON DATA CONSOLIDATORS July 15, 2009

There has been a new consolidator selected for NMVTIS program. However, at this time, designation of the data consolidator has not been disclosed, but should be announced shortly. ARA Service Corporation (Car-Parts.com and ARA) had submitted a proposal but were not picked at this time to be a consolidator. Car-Part.com intends to provide reporting capabilities to all Checkmate and Fast Parts customer which will allow them to create files containing the required NMVTIS inventory data in the formats designated by the various data consolidators. This will allow such Checkmate and Fast Parts customers to select the NMVTIS reporting option that works best for them. Checkmate and Fast Parts customers will need to contact one of the designated NMVTIS data consolidators for instructions on how to obtain an NMVTIS reporting entity identification number and how to make the required NMVTIS reporting.

The information listed below are for the PRESENT two approved data consolidators: **Auto Data Direct (ADD)** and **Insurance Services Organization (ISO)**. The fee structures vary for both consolidators and will require you to review and compare the services and pricing to find the program that fits your needs. Please note that these two consolidators use different formats for submitting data which could impact the choice you make. For those members not using an inventory management system, you should register with one of the approved data consolidators. If you plan on submitting your data through your inventory management system, please check with your respective vendors. TARA will provide the information on the new data consolidator when it is announced. Here is the contact information for each of the present data consolidators:

ENFORCEMENT CONCERNS

We have heard from a number of members who are concerned about the Department of Justice (DOJ) taking action against recyclers who have not yet registered with NMVTIS. DOJ has assured us that the Department is more concerned with compliance (getting recyclers registered) than with enforcement at this time. **Remember: When you do register, be prepared to submit your data for all inventory acquired since March 1, 2009.**
